# Puzzle .....

## MATHS PUZZLE OF THE WEEK

Find a HAPPY NUMBER? Come and show it to me (Mr Owusu in Room S2) for 7 Vivo miles.

*Some numbers are happy and others are not!*

*To find out whether a number is happy square each of its digits, add the answers and repeat. If you end up with 1 the number is happy!*

E.g. Consider 19

$$1^2 + 9^2 = 82$$

$$8^2 + 2^2 = 68$$

$$6^2 + 8^2 = 100$$

$1^2 + 0^2 + 0^2 = 1$  which means that 19 is a happy number.

*How many other happy numbers can you find?*
