

LAMBETH ACADEMY STUDENT UNIFORM POLICY 2020-2021

Wearing smart uniform

- helps to create the right conditions for learning
- enables students to take pride in belonging to a community
- encourages them to take pride in their appearance
- promotes equality

Students are expected to wear full Academy uniform on the way to and from the Academy. Sixth Form students will be expected to dress in formal suits and to set an example to the younger students.

Students who arrive at school without the correct uniform will either be asked to return home (with parental consent) to correct their uniform or they will undertake work in the reflection room until the uniform issue is rectified.

If you are in any doubt about details of the uniform policy, please contact the Academy in order to save time and any unnecessary expense. Please do not rely on assurances from students or shops because these are often incorrect.

Essential items of uniform, for example, Academy blazer, kilt, tie, jumper, PE kit are only available from the Academy uniform suppliers, School Uniform Direct (www.sud.co.uk).

	Description	Further Information	Supplier
Academy Blazer	Black with Lambeth Academy logo	To be kept smart and clean appearance To be worn at all times during the day, as well as to and from the Academy, unless directed otherwise by staff. Only original buttons to be used to fasten – no safety pins etc. Sleeves to be worn at full length, not rolled-up. Only Academy-issued badges to adorn the blazer.	www.sud.co.uk
Trousers	Grey, formal, tailored style, full length	No jean-like, corduroy, high-fashion, overly tight trousers, leggings, jeggings, skinny trousers or shorts. Trousers should be worn with a secure fit around the waist. Belts should be black , plain and functional, with no oversized buckles or trimmings	Any retailer
Skirt	Lambeth Academy kilt	Skirts must not be shortened by rolling up at the waist and must be worn at least knee length.	www.sud.co.uk
Shirt	Plain white traditional school shirt	The shirt should be tucked in, buttoned at the neck and sleeves worn at full length. No other clothing to be visible under the shirt. No designer shirts. A shirt must be worn accompanied by the Academy tie	Any retailer
Blouse	Plain white traditional blouse	The blouse should be tucked in, buttoned at the neck and sleeves worn at full length. No other clothing to be visible under the shirt. The blouse is not accompanied by the Academy tie	Any retailer
Tie	Lambeth Academy tie	Must be kept in good condition with colour visible in the stripes and worn with a closed knot covering the shirt collar button at the neck. Tie should be of appropriate length with at least four full stripes showing. The tie is only worn with a school shirt, not the blouse	www.sud.co.uk
Academy Jumper (Optional)	Grey with purple piping around the neck	Only the Academy jumper is to be worn.	www.sud.co.uk
Socks	Black	Must be plain, no pattern designs and worn below the knee. No pop socks. Not to be worn with tights.	Any retailer
Tights	Black	No footless, patterned or fishnet tights, leggings or legwarmers. Not to be worn with socks.	Any retailer
Shoes	Polished black, traditional style, black stitching, black sole and heel	A plain design, no trimmings, logos, decorative buckles, coloured laces or stitching, labels, tags, or other decorations. No shoe/trainer hybrid footwear, trainers, fabric shoes, or boots of any kind.	Any retailer

Coat/ Jacket (Optional)	Plain outdoor jacket or coat. Preferably plain black or navy.	Plain Coat/Jacket no large logo or pattern . Whenever possible it should be plain black or navy blue No hoodies or combination of fabric/knitted tops, cardigans, jumpers, sweatshirts, tracksuit tops, waistcoats, sleeveless tops, body warmers, denim jackets etc.	Any retailer
Scarf (Optional)	Plain black or Navy blue	Plain black or dark blue, no logo. No pashminas. If worn for religious reasons, head scarf should be plain black and correctly worn. Only scarfs worn for religious reasons are permitted inside the Academy building	Any retailer
Bag	Lambeth Academy Rucksack	From September 2020 Year 7 students will be required to have the Lambeth Academy Rucksack Y8-11 can continue to use their current school bag but should replace this with the Lambeth Academy Rucksack before September 2021. Bags must be suitable for carrying school books and PE kit. Plastic carrier bags, handbags, purse bags, shoulder pouches and other inappropriate fashion bags will not be permitted.	www.sud.co.uk
PE Polo Shirt	Navy blue with light blue stripe	Compulsory PE Kit Coloured/striped under-garments, other t-shirts or tops must not be visible.	www.sud.co.uk
PE sweatshirt (Optional)	Navy blue	Lambeth Academy logoed version only	www.sud.co.uk
PE Shorts	Navy blue	Compulsory PE Kit. Can be worn by boys or girls Lambeth Academy logoed version only to be worn	www.sud.co.uk
PE Skort	Navy blue	This is only required as an alternative to shorts Lambeth Academy logoed version only to be worn	www.sud.co.uk
PE Socks (optional)	Navy blue	Optional PE Kit Lambeth Academy logoed version only to be worn. If you choose not to wear the logoed socks, you must wear plain white socks for PE	www.sud.co.uk
PE Tracksuit Bottoms (Optional)	Navy blue	Recommended PE Kit for winter term outdoor activities Only Lambeth Academy logoed version to be worn.	www.sud.co.uk
PE Trainers	Any brand	Trainers must have non-marking soles. Plimsolls, canvas and high tops shoes must not be worn. Laces should be of the same colour as the trainers.	Any retailer
PE Cold Weather Wear	Base layers	Recommended PE Kit White long sleeved T-shirt or lightweight sport specific skins and black gloves.	Any retailer

Umbrella (Optional)	Telescopic, blue or black	Only telescopic umbrellas may be brought on site and should be collapsed and stored in the student's bag during the day.	Any retailer

FURTHER INFORMATION

Hair/Appearance	<p>Individual fashion statements such as extreme hairstyles or non- natural colours are not permitted. No hair dye is permitted, all students should have their natural hair colour only.</p> <p>Only black or dark blue hair accessories are allowed.</p> <p>No decorative attachments, coloured weaves or extensions are to be worn in the hair. Hair should be your natural colour. Shaved lines in the hair or eyebrows are not permitted.</p> <p>Extreme Shaved sides are not permitted. No scalp should be visible</p> <p>No makeup, e.g. lip gloss, mascara, eyeliner and eye shadow, Henna decorations, nail varnish, nail decorations, French tips or extensions are not permitted</p> <p>Tinted or cosmetic contact lenses and decorative dental wear are not permitted.</p> <p>No false eyelashes</p> <p>No hoods, hats, caps or bandannas to be worn anywhere on the Academy site.</p> <p>Fashion spectacles are not permitted.</p>
Jewellery/Valuables	<p>No jewellery except for one wrist watch and a maximum of one pair of small plain, gold or silver ball (no stones) stud earrings.</p> <p>Nose studs, facial and body piercings or visible tattoos are not permitted.</p> <p>Prohibited earrings or nose studs cannot be covered with a plaster.</p> <p>Clear nose plugs cannot be worn.</p> <p>Piercings should be done over the 6 weeks holiday to avoid uniform infringement issues as often stone earrings are used for piercings.</p> <p>No accessories are to be worn around the neck, wrists, and ankles or attached to clothing.</p> <p>Money should be kept in a purse or wallet securely on their person. Large amounts of money and expensive personal effects should not be brought on site.</p> <p>The Academy will not accept liability for any claim arising from theft, accidental loss or damage to personal effects, money, belongings or clothing whilst on the premises.</p> <p>Mobile phones, computer tablets/games etc. must not be brought on site.</p> <p>We operate a 'not seen, not heard' policy towards mobile phones.</p> <p>Confiscated items are to be collected at the end of half-term.</p>
Jumpers	<p>No pullovers, cardigans, sweatshirts, hoodies or waistcoats permitted other than the Academy jumper</p>
